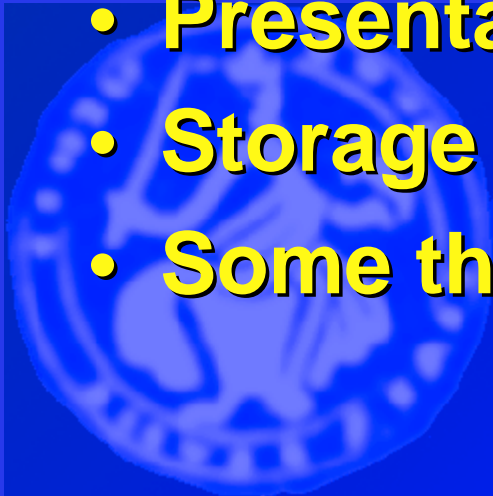

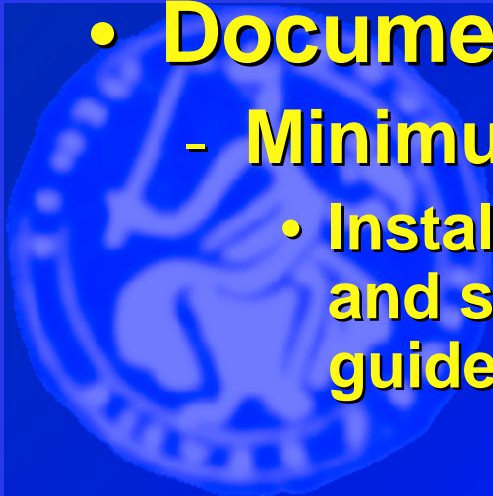
# Selection

    - **theoretical and practical**



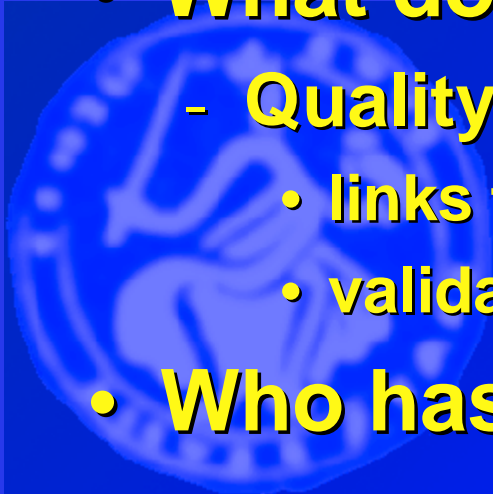
# Transfer

  - **Minimum required?**
    - **Installation guide, system description and support plan, user and admin guides, others....**

- **Who has looked at it and why?**

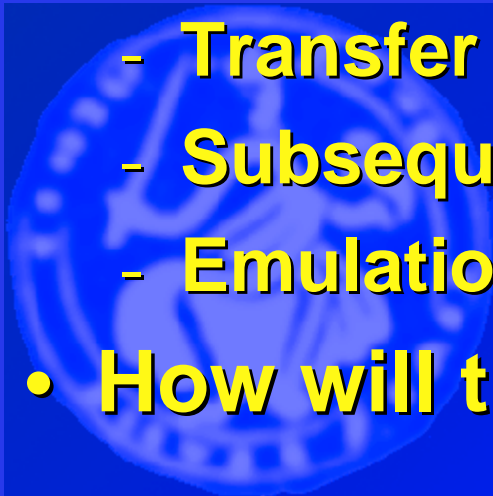
