We worked with the good folks from Tweetminster recently to put together a custom iFrame widget that we could use on the Parliament website.

This involved styling the widget Tweetminster already make available so that it fitted with the look of our new redesign, and specifying what Twitter feeds it would use. We wanted the widget to be "Parliament on Twitter" - so it uses our own @ukparliament feed, any MPs or Peers that use Twitter (are there any Peers using Twitter yet?), but no parliamentary candidates, government departments or political parties.

The hope is that using this widget will further promote how Parliament and its Members are trying to engage with social media tools and with the public. During recess it should also give an insight into the work of MPs in their constituencies. Although, we have included a disclaimer because the Web Centre team is responsible only for the content of @ukparliament updates, not

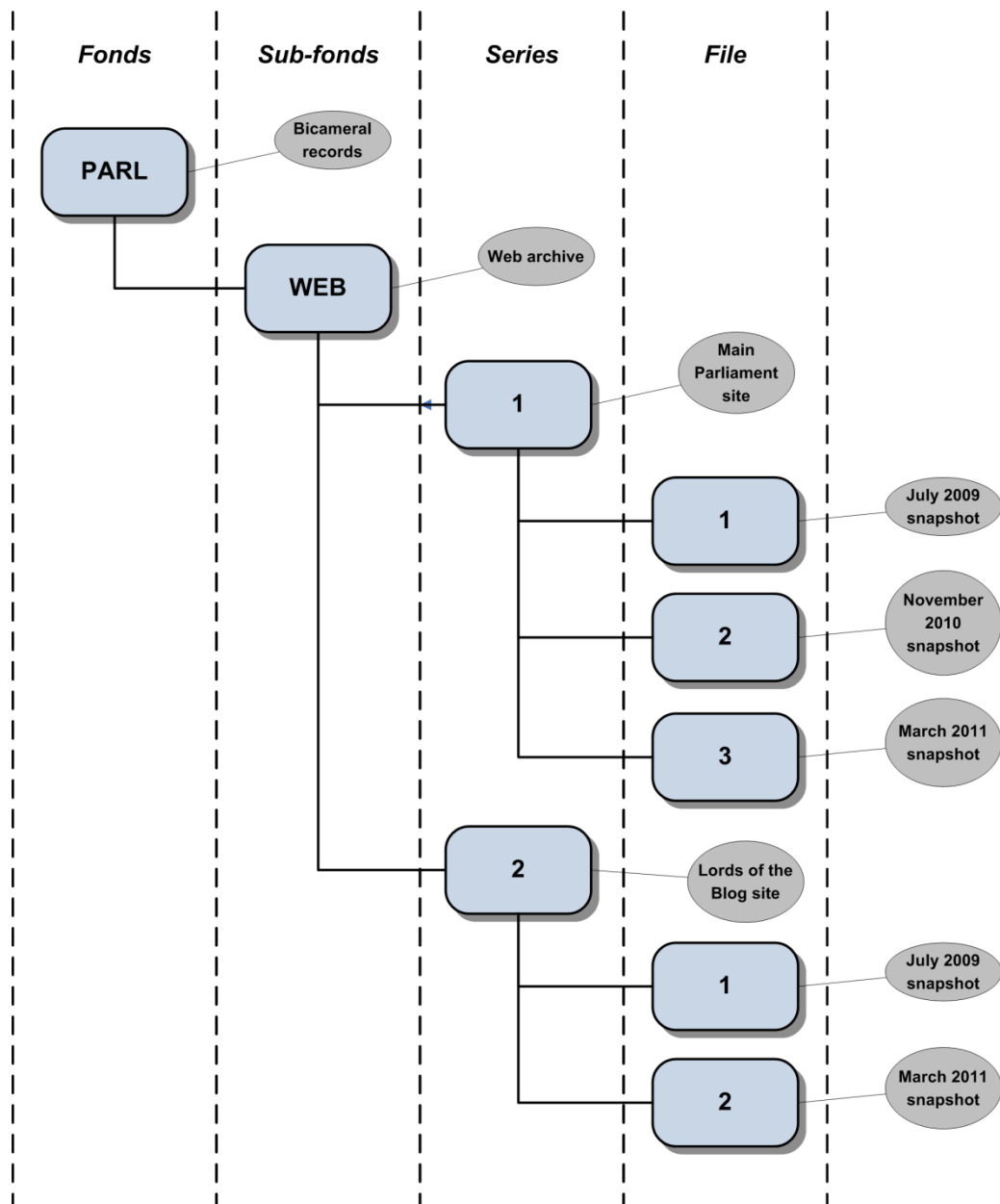



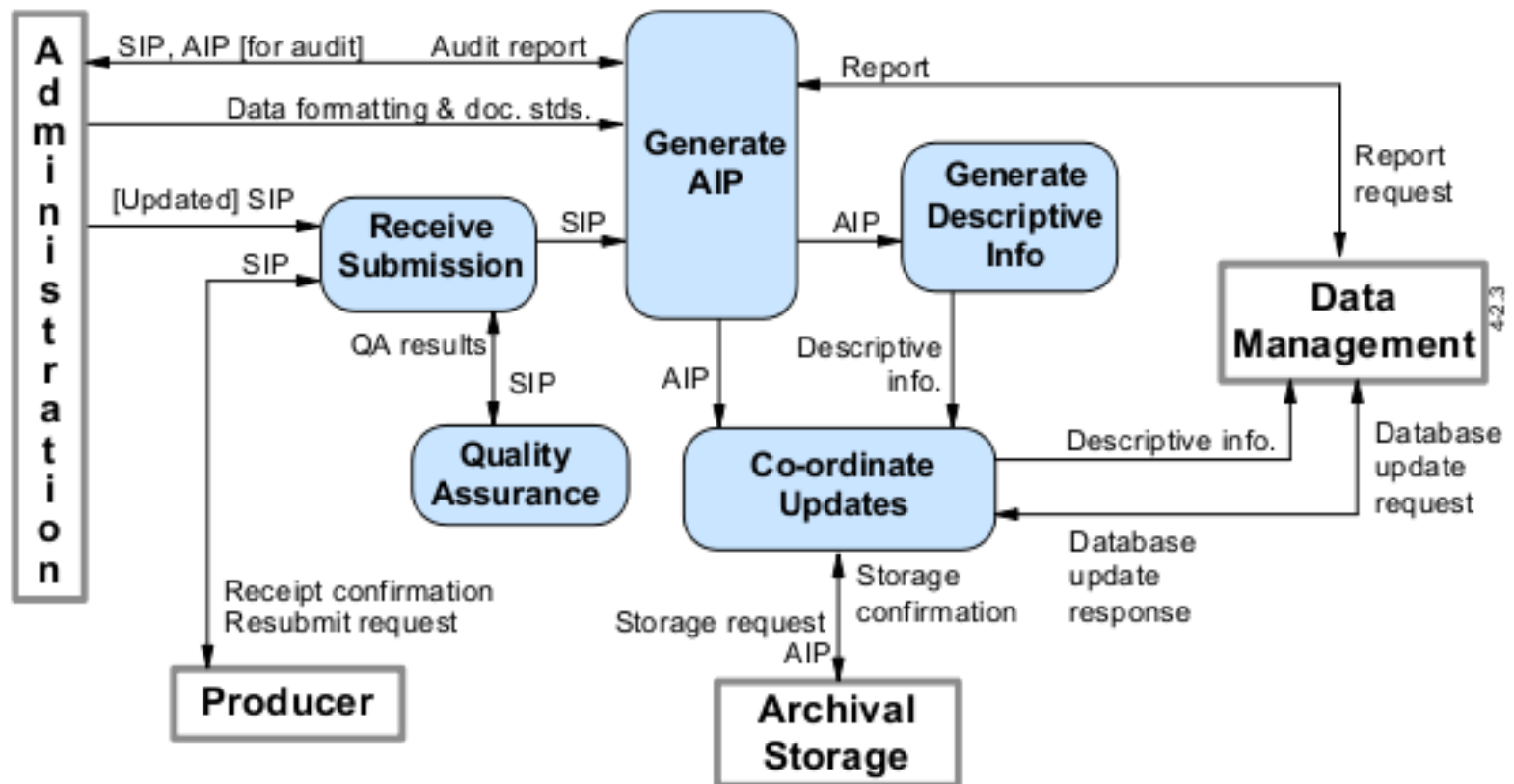

**E.H.H. CARLILE,**  
Hertfordshire Yeomanry.  
(and Hertfordshire Regiment.)

**E**DWARD HILDKED SANBURY CARLILE, only son of Colonel Sir Hildred Carlile, Bart., C.B.E., M.P. for St. Albans Division of Hertfordshire, 1906-1919, was born on January 28<sup>th</sup> 1881. He was educated at Harrow and Trinity College, Cambridge, boxing successfully as a featherweight for his University against Oxford. He was a lieutenant in the Yorkshire Dragoons, a barrister of the Inner Temple, and from 1906 to 1914 was engaged in farming in Canada. He joined the Army in September 1914, and proceeded overseas on January 18<sup>th</sup> 1918. He was killed in action two months later, at Villers Faucon, near Peronne, while leading a forlorn hope on March 22<sup>nd</sup> 1918.

**H**is name is perpetuated on the Arras Memorial.

2<sup>nd</sup> Lieut. **D.A. CARNEGIE.**  
Royal Field Artillery.

**D**AVID ALEXANDER CARNEGIE, second son of Lieut.-Col. the Hon. Douglas Carnegie, M.P. for Winchester, 1916-18, and grandson of the 9<sup>th</sup> Earl of Northesk, was born on January 15<sup>th</sup> 1897. He was educated at Gresham's School, Holt, Norfolk, and instead of going to Cambridge as was intended, went to Woolwich. He received a commission in May 1916, and was immediately sent out to France, where he took part in the engagements at Mametz and Contalmaison. He was killed in action by the explosion of an enemy shell in his battery at Brielen, near Ypres, on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of April, 1917, and was buried at Ferme-Oliver military cemetery at Elverlinghe in Flanders.

**T**he Colonel commanding his Brigade wrote:-

*"He was a splendidly gallant fellow who has done magnificent work always. He could always be absolutely depended upon, and his powers of observation and initiative were exceptional. His reports were always reliable."*

*Both officers and men were most awfully fond of him."*

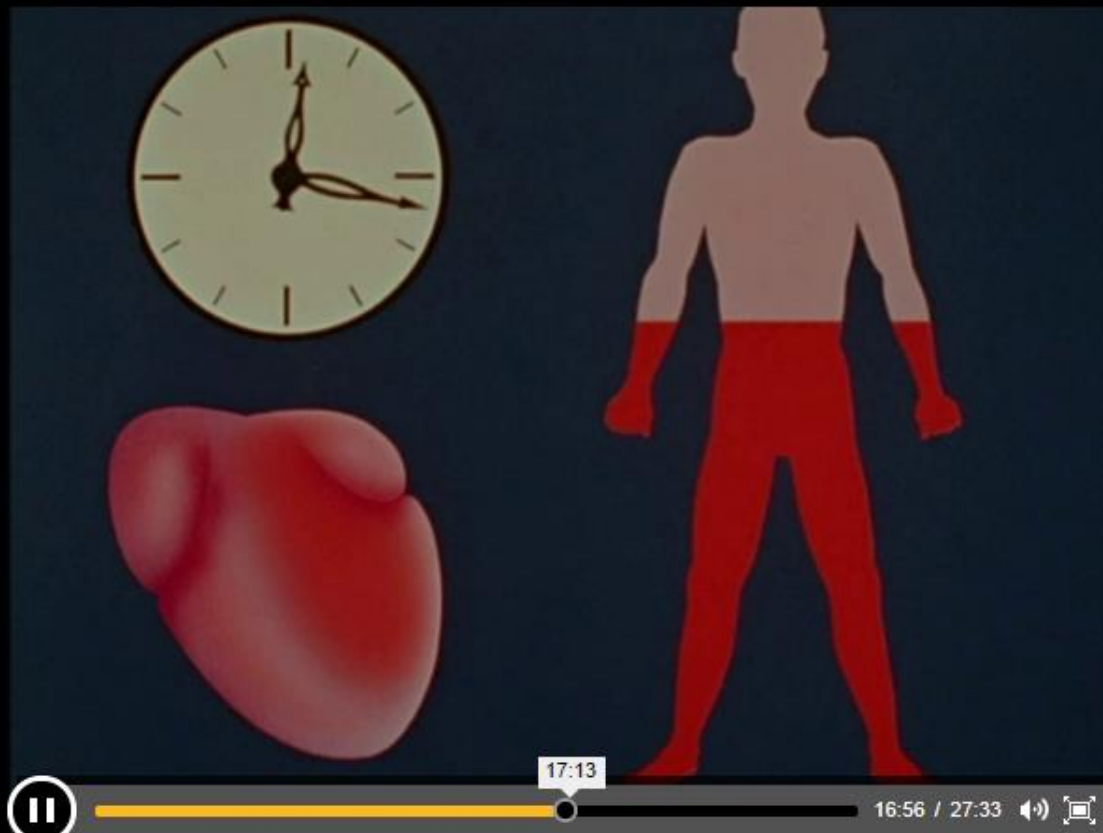
