- We run our own web sites
- We host other people's web sites
- We have to archive some government sites
- We'd like to be able to archive lots of web sites
- We're not happy about any of it

#### Our own sites



- Mixture of static, database-driven and exotic content
- ◆ There really shouldn't be a problem...
- ... but the will has to be there

### Other sites we host



- Facility provided since 1994
- Updated via in-house CMS
- Designed for easy error recovery
- It gives potential infinite regress
- People were itchy about copyright

### Government sites



- ◆ The owners do try to help…
- but a little knowledge is a dangerous thing
- PDF and screendumps aren't the answer, are they?
- Need to think what the purpose is, and what are the 'significant properties'

## Experiments elsewhere



- Pilot with another London institution
- Central site as well as departmental
- Capture is easy (luckily)
