CLOCKSS is a **dark archive** founded by the world's leading libraries and publishers to keep archiving in the hands of the **community**.

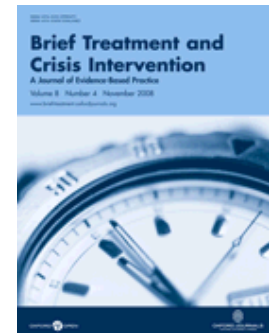
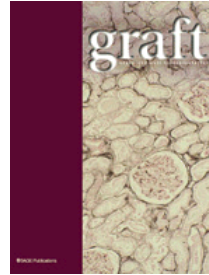


CLOCKSS: Four Unique Benefits

4. Low fees

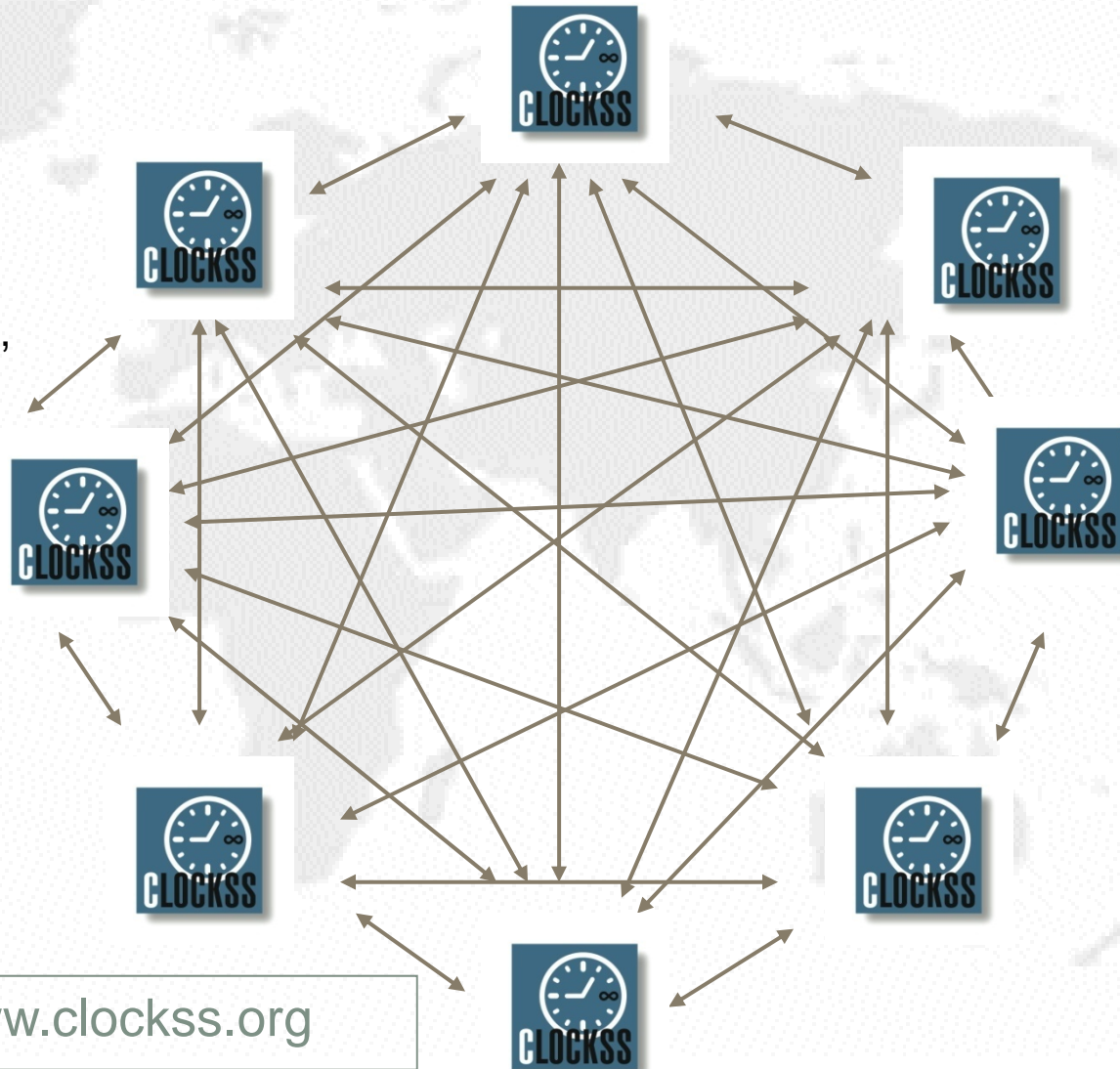
