High safety

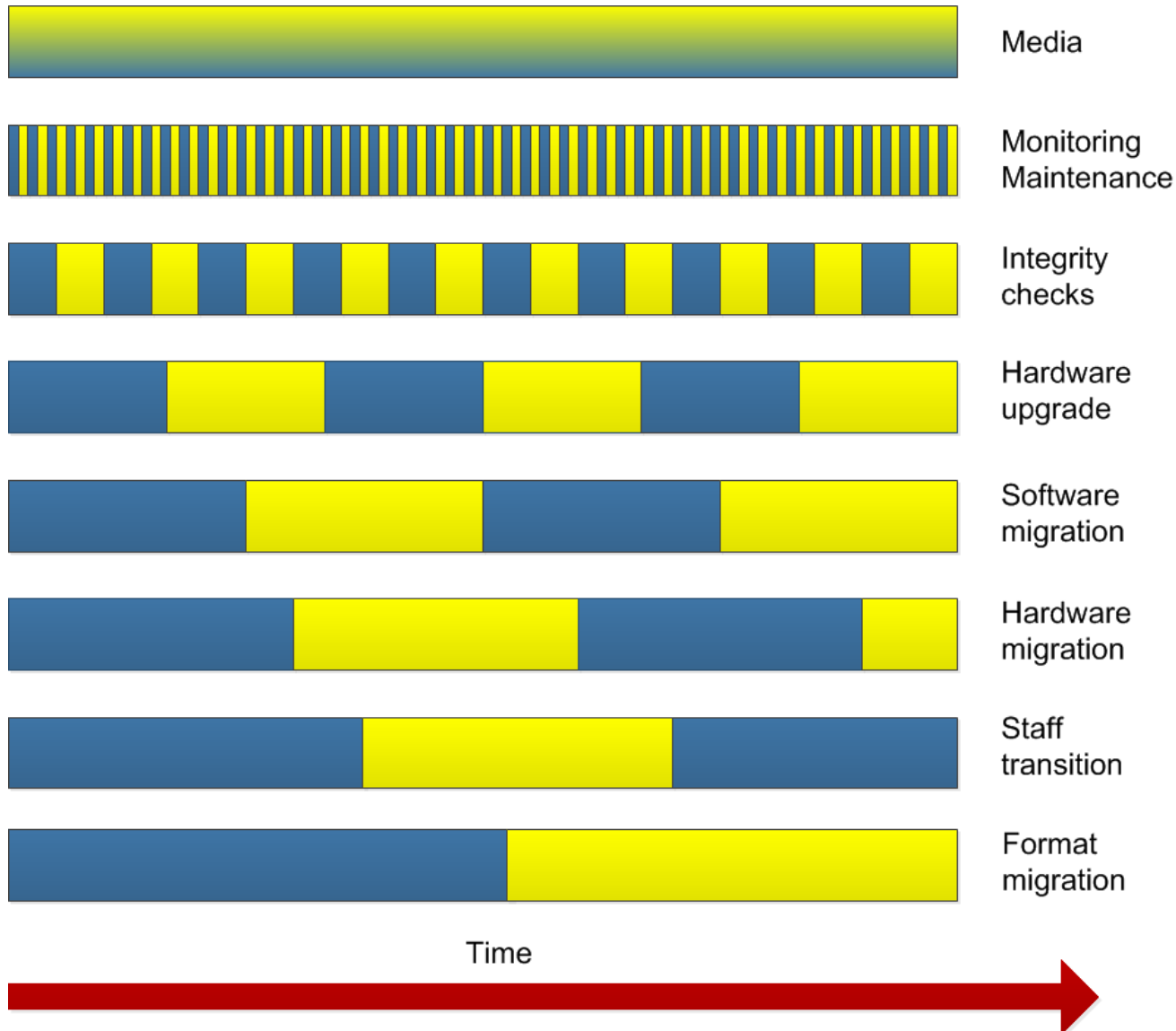
- Requirements: reuse, compliance

Ingredients

- Skilled and trained people

Built in exit-strategy

- Full copy of data in escrow (encrypted)
- Metadata and data on a file system
- Open standards and formats
- 3-way agreement on ownership/access
- Drive down costs and risks

Observations on the Digital Preservation Community

- Complex and challenging landscape
- Long timescales, limited budgets
- Reluctance to act
- Fear of doing the wrong thing

- Emerging products and services
- Specialist vendors
- Need for long-term partnerships
- Nurture the shoots



Thoughts on requirements

- Specify what's needed, not how to do it
 - Allows flexibility on design/implementation
 - More likely to be future proof
 - Think services, contracts and SLAs
 - Technology is only a small part of preservation



Thoughts on requirements

- Try not to be alone
 - Bespoke = time, cost, risk
 - Commonality = market, user base, multipliers
 - Use standards and shared specifications
- Safety and strength in numbers
 - Paradox of ‘You don’t get fired for buying IBM’



Thoughts on requirements

- Dialog
 - Discussion, clarification, advice
 - Demos, proof of concept, pilots, trials
 - Both sides learn a lot through small steps
 - Cut down the costs and the risks



Example: Tate Gallery

- Well defined ITT
- Specific about needs
 - Volumes
 - Safety
 - Access
 - Timeframe
 - Budget
- Discussion as part of the process
- Ongoing collaboration

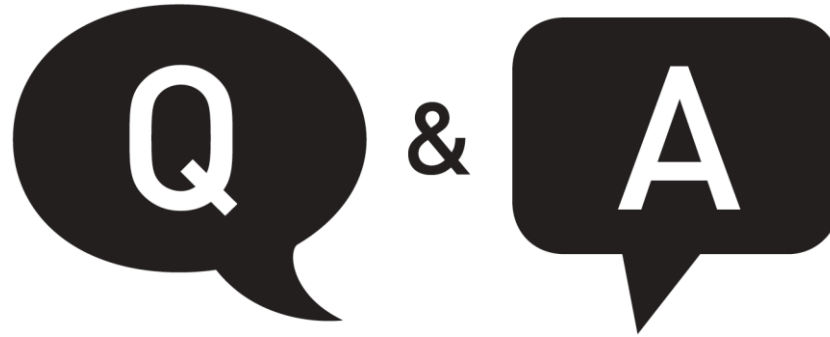


Example: University of Leeds

- ePrints integration
- Joint specification of workflows
- Joint agreement on scope and approach
- Proof of concept → Pilot
- Sharing of results with other Universities
 - Scenarios, development work, testing
 - Problem shared is a problem solved
