- Running an e-Depot since 2003
- E-journal archiving (STM)
- International focus from the start
- Alongside with digital preservation research
- Digital Library Program
  - From analog to digital library
  - Redesigning technical infrastructure





# Roadmap international e-Depot

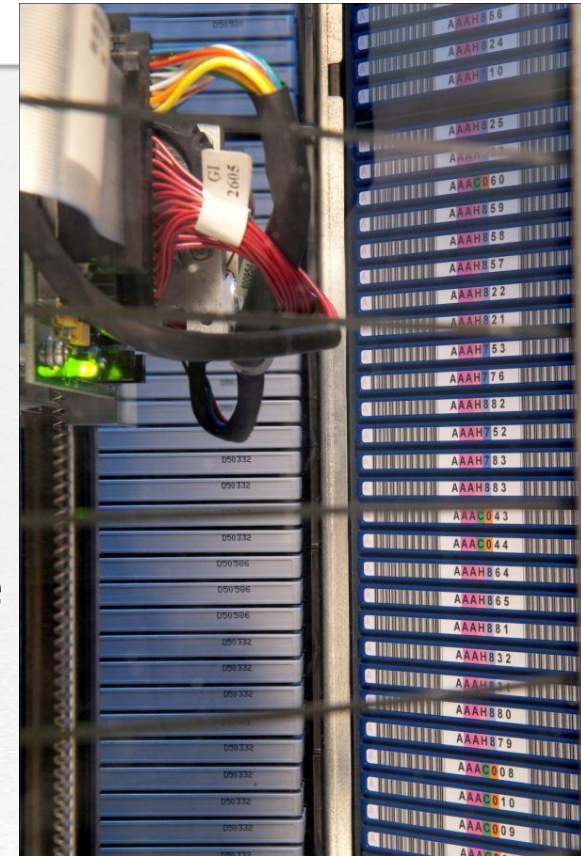
- International e-Depot is core in strategy of the KB
- Programme started in 2011 for redeveloping current i-e-Depot
- Core elements
  - Development new archival infrastructure (KB infrastructure)
  - Development of business model
  - Acquisition publishers and libraries (large, small, OA)
  - Trigger event and post-cancellation access
- Collaboration in safe places network
  - Coverage
  - Research

# Roadmap forthcoming years

- New business model in 2012
- New storage environment in 2013
- New ingest workflow in 2015
- Agreements with 80 publishers in 2018
- Dutch big deals in 2015
- Large portion Open Access titles via DAOJ
- Trigger event access in 2015
- Post-cancellation access in 2016
- Start audit & certification process in 2015 (3 steps)
- Mirror abroad in 2017

## The KB international e-Depot

- is a service to guarantee permanent access to international academic publications for the European research community
- is a service which helps libraries and publishers solve their problems
- is based on a business model in which stakeholders participate and take responsibility
- Is partnering with libraries, publishers and other archival solutions in a network of safe places
- Is investing in infrastructure and ongoing research



# Who benefits?

## **Researchers**

- Permanent access to records of sciences to ensure future research

## **Libraries**

- Investments in licenses and serve researchers and students

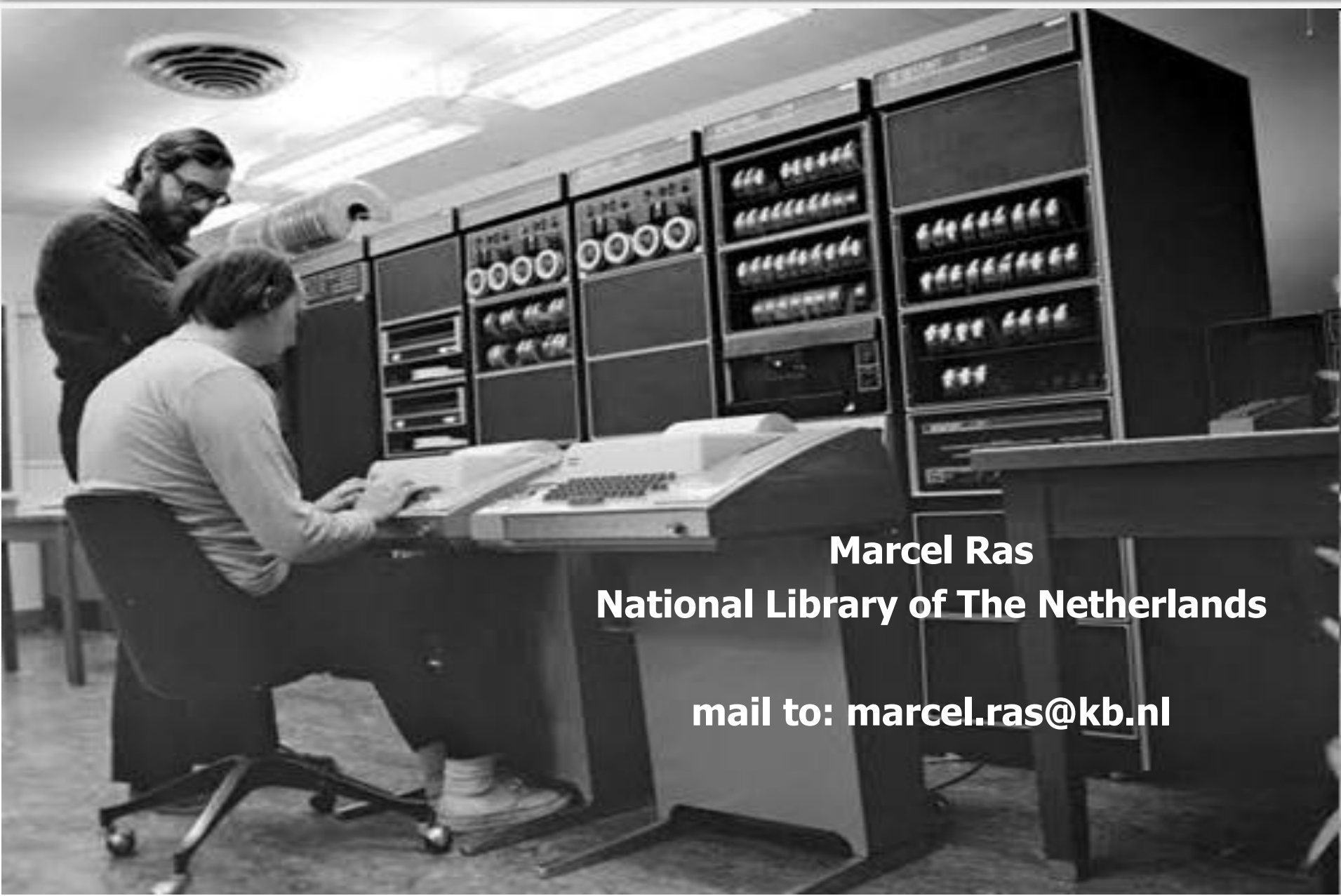
## **Publishers**
