- Method of measuring performance
- Should be based on what's important to the organisation
- Most KPIs focus upon measures such as:

 - improving revenue reducing costs increasing efficiency improving customer satisfaction

Jargon: Quantitative vs. Qualitative

Quantitative

Quantitative KPIs measure data in numerical terms, such as sales figures or website traffic.

Qualitative

Qualitative KPIs measure nonnumerical data and are described as "descriptive" characteristics or subjective interpretations of a person's opinions. Q: Can we measure impact beyond simple statistics?

Q: How can we flag quality over quantity?

Q: Can we measure the cultural impact?

Q: Can KPIs be environmentally sustainable?
