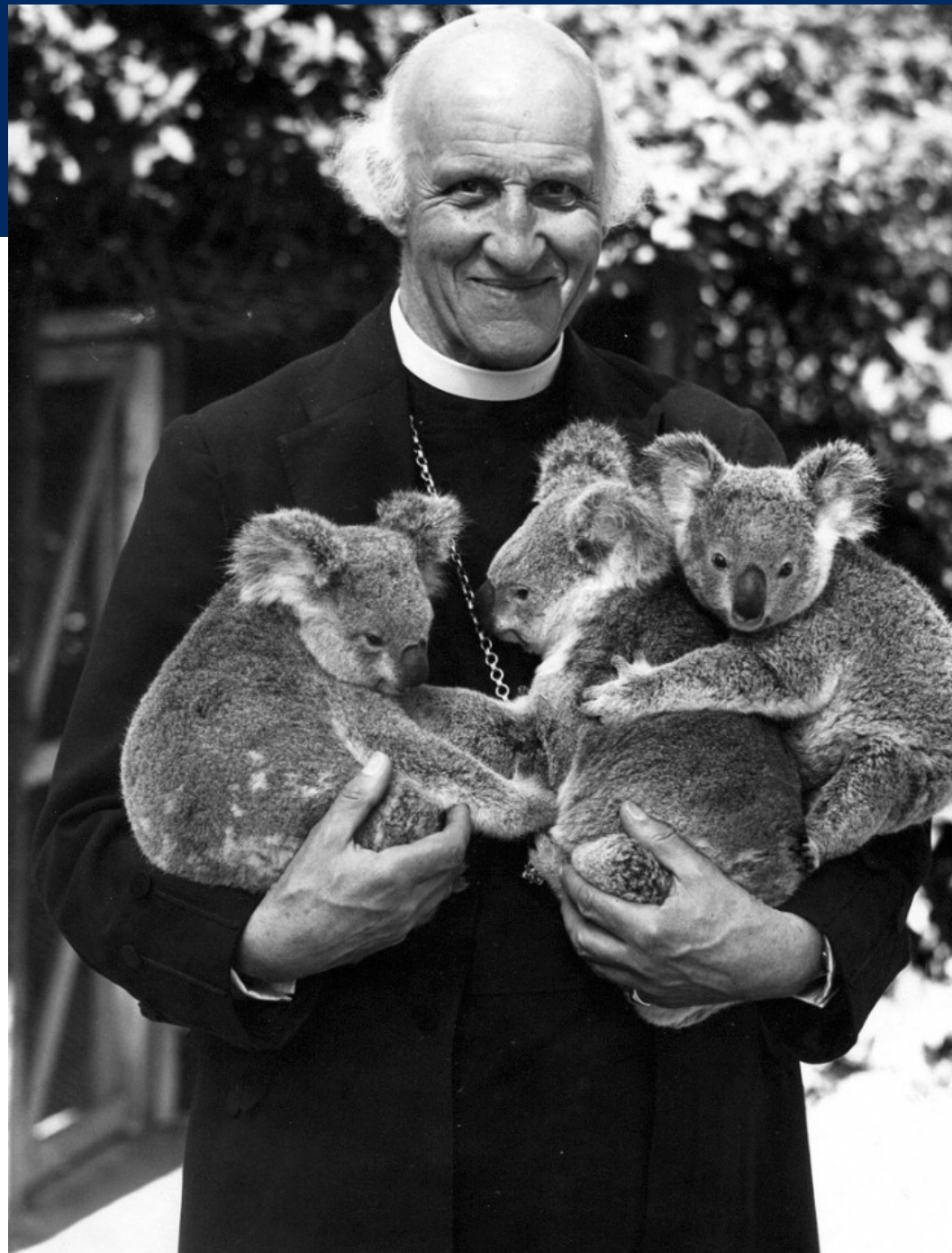



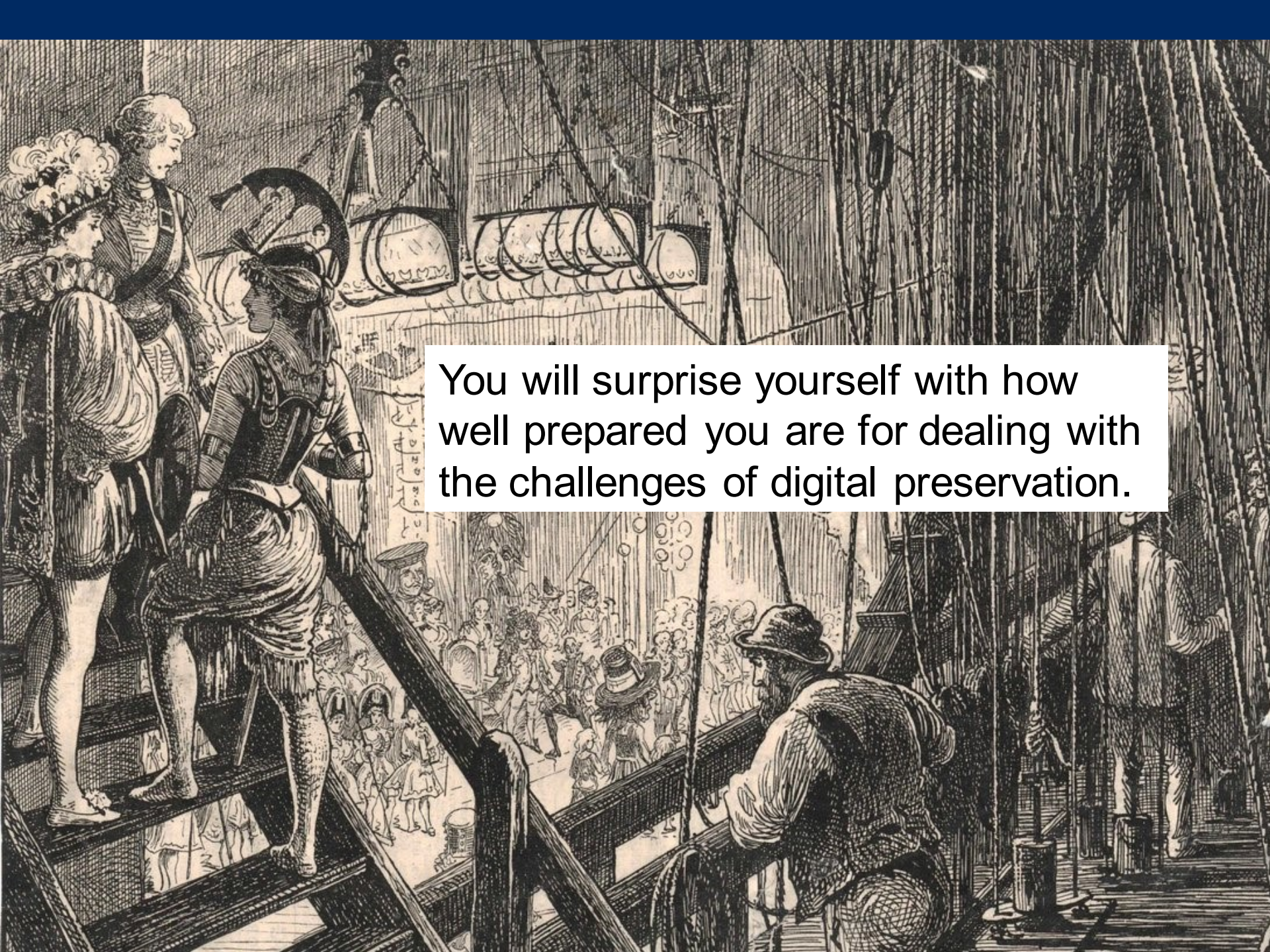
Imposter syndrome is common among information professionals.
