

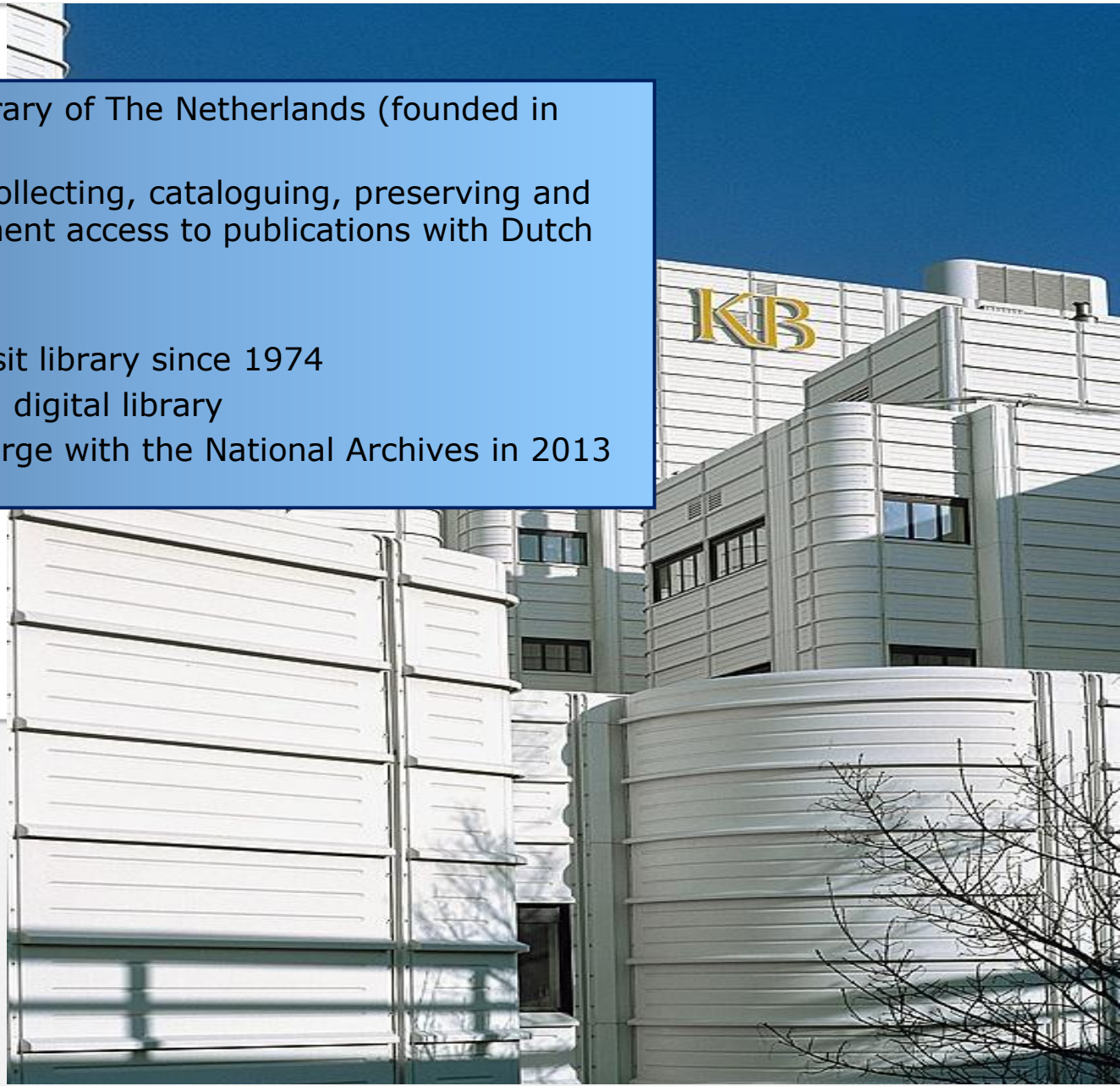

- KB is national library of The Netherlands (founded in 1789)
- Responsible for collecting, cataloguing, preserving and providing permanent access to publications with Dutch imprint
- 275 fte
- (voluntary) deposit library since 1974
- Moving towards a digital library
- And ... we will merge with the National Archives in 2013

- LTA for international academic literature for Dutch scholars
 - National deposit
 - Operational since 2003
 - Based on international standards (OAIS)
 - Integrated with other library modules
 - Restricted access (on-site) & ILL
 - 18 million e-journal articles
 - Also e-books, digitised materials, websites
 - Continuous research and development (EU projects on DP)
 - DIAS = end of life

- Development 2nd generation DP system
- Preservation functionalities

- International e-Depot as a European service
- Guarantee access to international, academic publications for the European researcher community

- Post-cancellation
- Trigger events
- On-site
- On-line
- ILL / pay per view document delivery service
